This Living Special Collection highlights work that bridges policy and systems, and advances implementation science and knowledge translation across policy, organisational, community, and point-of-care settings. We especially encourage manuscripts that examine how evidence moves through real systems, shaping decisions, informing decision-making, improving services, and strengthening health and social outcomes.

Scope

JBI Evidence Implementation publishes manuscripts that explore the theoretical, methodological and practical aspects of implementation, including broader knowledge translation papers related to human health and wellbeing. We particularly encourage work that examines decision-making processes, organisational or policy mechanisms, partnerships that enable implementation in complex systems, with attention to sustainability and equity as core dimensions of lasting impact. Submissions may include research studies, conceptual or methodological papers, implementation frameworks, case studies, or applied quality improvement with an implementation lens.
